Discussion

- 1. Read Genesis 4:17-24. How do verses 23-24 show us the growing effect of sin on humans? What tangible difference do you see in Cain's line verses Seth's line (verse 26)?
- 2. Read Genesis 5:3. How does this reflect language that we have seen before in chapter 1?
- 3. Why do you think the writer emphasizes the death of each of Seth's descendants in verses 5:4-31, and not Cain's in 4:17-24?
- 4. How does this emphasis make Enoch's experience in 5:22-24 even more unique? How does this foreshadow Revelation 21:4?
- 5. Read and compare each pair of verses from Genesis and Revelation. What are your observations and conclusions? Genesis 3:14-15 & Revelation 20:10, Gen 1:3-5 & Rev 21:23, Gen 2:9-10 & Rev 22:1-2, Gen 1:31 & Rev 22:3-5.
- 6. Read 1 Corinthians 15:45-49. What does Paul's statement that Adam was the "first man" suggest to you? If humans developed slowly over millions of years, how does that affect Paul's comparison of Adam & Jesus?
- 7. Read 1 Corinthians 15:42-44. What patterns in creation is Paul using to help us understand the resurrection?
- 8. Read 1 Corinthians 15:50-57. How will the curse be removed in our resurrected form? Close by thanking God for his plan to give us life forever.
