START

MAN UP

- What are some of the cultural and secular traits that people look for in the people they allow to influence their lives?
- Read Titus 1:7-9 and 1 Timothy 3:8-13, 4:12. Qualities for church leaders make them effective influencers. What are some of the traits mentioned in these verses that can help us influence others? How are these different than cultural and secular traits?
- Dr Evans mentioned three qualities to develop to become a Kingdom Influencer. What are they?
- Read Psalms 78:72. This verse mentions some of David's shepherding skills. What two qualities of an influencer do you find here?
- Read Romans 14:9. Why does it take commitment to pursue something? How is pursuing peace different than what we find in most relationships? What does it mean to "build others up"? Why is it that most relationships demonstrate the opposite of these traits?
- Read Deuteronomy 30:19. The point of Dr Evans closing story was, "The answer is in your hand." How does this verse reinforce this idea? What choices do you need to make to become a key influencer in your circle?

PRAYER

- Who are the people in your circle to whom you would like to be a key influencer?
- Pray for God to show you who to influence and to direct you on how you can become a key influencer.
